Oral Presentation

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

1. The total duration allotted to each Oral Presentation is **10 minutes** including Q & A
2. Only the presenting and registered authors can present, within the given timeline.
3. The presenters are advised to focus on the concise objectives of the study, data & methodology in brief, salient results of the study, and important conclusions.
4. Only Power Point presentations, **Office 2019 or newer versions** for PC/Laptop, are accepted. (The Power Point version used is Office 2019 for best compatibility reasons). If you have pictures, they must be in the following format: .jpg, .gif, .tiff, or.bmp (format .pict is NOT accepted).
5. There will be no possibility to connect your own laptop/MacBook. **PLEASE DO NOT REQUEST.**
6. A laptop will be available at the podium for the speakers to use during the session. Laser pointers will be provided during the presentation.
7. On the day of your presentation arrive 45 minutes before your session is due to start for the setup. Please bring your presentation in a compatible format (e.g., Power Point or PDF) on a pen drive/ USB as a backup and should be emailed to secretariat@wcn2026.in as per the prescribed guidelines only maximum by 25.09.2026 (12:00pm IST)
8. Ensure your presentation is saved with a clear, identifiable file name (e.g., AbstractID_PresenterName).

Poster Display

POSTER SPECIFICATION:

Your poster space will be **3.89 ft** height and **2.75 ft** width (A0 portrait). Each poster will be provided with one panel each. Please ensure that your poster follows the template uploaded on the website.

POSTER DISPLAY AND PRESENTATION:

You are requested to mount and dismantle your poster at the designated time on the day advised for your poster display:

1. The poster presenters are required to stay at the poster site during poster evaluation by the reviewer committee
2. Posters must be dismounted on the same day after the session is over. Any posters that are not dismounted by the required time will be removed.
3. You will be provided with double adhesive tapes to display your poster on the panel boards.
4. Your poster number will be available on the poster board.
5. The organizing Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage to posters after the session is over.
6. Posters need to be printed by the participants on A0 Paper with 300 dpi and brought to the venue on your presentation date, so that it is up before the congress starts.
